

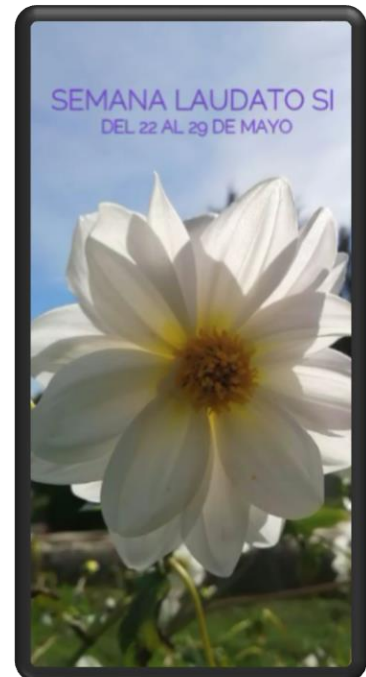


LAUDATO SI WEEK
